- ✓ Are your house numbers visible from the street?
- ✓ Is Your street address legible and placed in a position that is in front of your property and visible from the street?
- ✓ Are your house numbers placed on contrasting background and well lit?
- ✓ Is your mobile home identified with your house number?

Hydrants buried in snow are difficult to see and access! In the moments it takes for firefighters to dig a path to a hydrant, the fire could double in size.

What You Need To Know

- A fire can double in size every minute
- A fire truck typically carries a limited supply of water
- Fire fighters can't battle flames as quickly if hydrants are blocked or buried
- Is a fire hydrant within your property? You're responsible for keeping your hydrant clear
- **Snow/Brush/Debris** should be cleared to allow a clear path to the fire hydrant
